(a) to (c) The funds for the major rural development programmes are directly remitted to the District Rural Development Agencies (DRDAs)/Zilla Parishads (ZPs)/Implementing Agencies. As per the National common Minimum Programe (NCMP) the Government after consultations with the States, will consider crediting elected Panchayats with funds directly. There is no proposals of direct funding to Panchayati Raj Institutions for Rural Development Schemes at present.
