Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any survey has been conducted to assess the actual number of beneficiaries from vocational training in tribal areas and collect full data of the trainees who have gained employment after completion of vocational courses;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the time by which the said survey is proposed to be conducted by the Government?

Answer

MINISTER OF TRIBAL AFFAIRS (SHRI P.R. KYNDIAH)

(a) to (d) In order to assess the impact of the scheme of Vocational Training Centres (VTCs) all the State Govts. were asked to indicate the number of candidates who are earning their livelihood through the training received by them in the VTCs. From the information received from some of the State Govts, it is seen that on an average one third of the trained candidates get gainfully employed.

Further, the Planning Commission has been requested to conduct a survey/evaluation of VTCs, through their Project Appraisal and Management Division.
