- (a) Whether there is any proposal for conversion of Bareilly-Pilibhit- Dudwa-Sitapur-Lucknow railway line into broad gauge line;
- (b) If so, the present status of the said proposal; and
- (c)The time by which the Bareilly-Pilibhit-Dudwa-Sitapur-Lucknow railway line is likely to be converted into broad gauge line?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI R. VELU)

- (a): No, Sir. However, Bareilly-Bhojipura gauge conversion has been taken up. Further, Bhojipura-Pilibhit has been processed for necessary approval as part of Bhojipura-Pilibhit-Tanakpur gauge conversion project.
- (b) & (c): Bareilly-Bhojipura is likely to be completed in next 2-3 years as per availability of resources.
