(a) to (e): Ministry of Heavy Industries and Public Enterprises essentially deals with Central Public Sector related matters. So far as this Ministry is concerned, there is no proposal to set up new industries or units of existing industries in the country. No industrial project proposals have been received from State Governments in this regard during the last three years and till date this year.
