(a)&(b): Land Reforms is an ongoing process. State Governments are advised by the Ministry of Rural Development, Department of Land Resources in the periodic conferences of Revenue Ministers/Revenue Secretaries to expedite Land Reforms. The progress of Land reform is monitored by Quarterly Progress Report,

(c)&(d): State Governments are advised to take effective steps to get the land-dispute cases disposed off by Special efforts.
