- (c) to (e): The Central Universities, being autonomous bodies, established and incorporated by the Acts of Parliament, the appointments to various posts, including teaching posts therein, are made by the Executive Council/Board of Management of respective Central Universities on the recommendations of the Selection Committees constituted in terms of the relevant statutory
- 1. Provisions. The UGC has informed that some posts are lying vacant in Central Universities funded by it (list enclosed). The role of Ministry is limited to providing nominees of the Visitors on the Selection Committees for appointment to the teaching posts in various Central universities. The relevant proposals in this behalf have already been processed.
