- (a): Details of the funds released by the Government of India to State Governments for the development of urban slum areas under Valmiki Ambedkar Awas Yojana
- (VAMBAY) during each of the last three years, State-wise, are at Annexure-I.
- (b)&(c): The funds released by the Union Government under VAMBAY have not been fully utilized by the State Governments. Details of the utilization of funds and the achievements made under the scheme are at Annexures II and III respectively.
- (d): The reasons for underutilization of funds under VAMBAY scheme, inter-alia, include -.SP1
- (i) Low unit cost of the house,
- (ii) No provision of funds for the development of infrastructure,
- (iii) Lack of availability of suitable land for housing,
- (iv) Litigation pertaining to land.

As VAMBAY scheme has been implemented through the State Governments, the Government of India has been vigorously pursuing the matter with them for effective utilization of funds.
