- (a): Number of homeless people in million plus cities as per Registrar General of India for the Year 1991 and 2001 is at Annexure-I.
- (b): Government of India has launched the Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM) to assist cities and towns in taking up housing and infrastructural facilities for the urban poor in 63 cities in the country under the Basic Services to the Urban Poor (BSUP) Programme. For non-Mission cities, the Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme (IHSDP) has been launched with the objective to strive for holistic slum development, with a healthy and enabling environment by providing adequate shelter and basic infrastructure facilities to the slum dwellers including the displaced. Both BSUP and IHSDP are under implementation since December 2005. The duration of JNNURM would be seven years beginning from 2005-06.
- (c): Details of progress made under these schemes are given at Annexure-II.
