## Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION be pleased to state:

(a) Whether the Government proposes to implement National Foodgrains Storage Policy;

(b) If so, the details thereof alongwith the salient features thereof ;

(c) Whether the construction work for new godowns is being handed over to the private sector under the new foodgrains storage policy; and

(d) If so, the steps taken to protect the interests of the consumers under this policy?

## Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD & PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (DR. AKHILESH PRASAD SINGH)

(a): Yes, Sir. The Government is implementing the National policy on handling, storage and transportation of foodgrains.

(b):The policy envisages encouragement of private sector for the creation of bulk grain handling, storage and transportation facilities.The salient features of the policy are:

(i) Encouragement of mechanical harvesting, cleaning and drying at farm and mandi level.

(ii) Transportation of grain from farm to silos by specially designed trucks.

(iii) Construction of a chain of silos at procurement as well as distribution points.

(iv) Transportation of grain in specially designed bulk rail wagons.

(c) : Under the policy, bulk grain handling, storage and transportation facilities to the tune of 5.5 lakh MTs are being created through private sector participation on Build-Own-Operate (BOO) basis.

(d): The quality of wheat stored in such facilities (silos) would be maintained and the interest of the consumers would be protected.
