CONVERSION OF NH 2 FROM FOUR TO SIX LANES

- (a) the present status of progress of conversion of NH-2 from Delhi to Palwal from four to six lanes including the construction of Suraj Kund Bye-pass;
- (b) the steps taken to expedite the completion of the said project; and
- (c) the time by which the project is likely to be completed ?

(a) to (c) Delhi-Palwal section of the existing four lane National Highway-2 has been approved for six laning as part of National Highways Development Project Phase -V on which only preparatory work to award consultancy has been taken up. Six laning of this section is targeted for completion by 2010.
