(a)to(c) : Yes, Sir. The 22nd India Economic Summit, organized by the Confederation of Indian Industry and the World Economic Forum, was held during 26 to 28th November 2006 in New Delhi. The event brought together on a common platform, over 600 business, political and civil society leaders from over 30 countries, to deliberate on India-centric issues, such as State & National competitiveness, managing Growth, risk management and Infrastructure development. Since the event was organized by private/non-governmental organizations, the Government is not directly concerned with the implementation of its outcome though the Central and many State Governments take it into account in their policy formulation and implementation.
