(a) to (c): No, Sir. Doubling of a section is taken up only when the line capacity is saturated subject to operational requirement and availability of resources.

At present 89 doubling projects are in various stages of progress all over the country and in addition 5 new doublinhg works have been included in the budget 2004-05. These projects on completion will add about 2531 kms of additional track.
