(c)to(d): The University Grants Commission (UGC) is entrusted with the responsibility of determination and maintenance of standards of teaching, examination and research in Universities. In order to ensure maintenance of standards in University education, the Commission has notified rules and regulations on different subjects. The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) was established by the UGC to assess and accredit institutions of higher education in the country.
