## MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTERY OF DEFENCE PRODUCTION (RAO INDERJIT SINGH)

(a)to(e): No case of involvement of any army official in smuggling of ammunition from Ordnance Factories premises, to extremist groups has come to the notice so far. However, some empty Mines cases, produced by private firm for Ordnance Factories, have been seized by the Police Authorities. These empty bodies have been missing from the concerned private firm's premises and not from the Ordnance Factories.
