(a)to(d): Government have approved the project to construct 572 meters long cable stayed bridge at Kilometer 14.74 on Dunera-Darban-Basohli-Bani-Bhadarwah road in Jammu & Kashmir at the approximate cost of Rs. 70 crores. Tender documents for the bridge, based on the feasibility study have been finalized. Work on bridge is planned to be completed by December 2008. A sum of Rs.39.00 lacs has been spent on feasibility study of the bridge till 2005-2006. Rs.63.83 lacs have been earmarked for the bridge during 2006-2007.
