- (d) whether All India Federation of Horological Industries (AIFHI) has requested the Government for rationalization of duty on watch and watch components; and
- (e) if so, the reaction of the Government thereto?

(a)&(b) Yes, Sir. The following are the details of smuggled watches/parts seized during the last three financial years:

(c) All field formations including Directorate of Revenue Intelligence have been adequately sensitized to maintain strict vigil to prevent and thwart the smuggling of watches and parts thereof.

(d) &(e); Yes, Sir. Ministry has recently received a representation from All India Federation of Horological Industries (AIFHI) for rationalization of duty on watch and watch components. The said representation is under examination.
