- (a) whether the Government proposed to computerise Akashvani Kendras for providing better services;
- (b) if so, the details of the estimated cost to be incurred on computerisation of each Akashvani Kendra; and
- (c) the time by which the final decision is likely to be taken in this regard?

- (a): Yes Sir.
- (b) & (c): For computerization of AIR Stations/offices there are two schemes under 10th Plan viz. Scheme (I) Computerization of 38 AIR stations not having computers which has a provision of 68 Desktop computers with peripherals at an estimated cost of Rs.41.00 lakhs. This scheme has already been implemented. Scheme-II Computerization of 188 AIR Stations/Offices has a provision of 414 No. of Desktop computers with peripherals and networking at an estimated cost of Rs.390.00 lakhs. This scheme is likely to be implemented during the year 2006-07.
