Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) the present status of the proposed Paradip Oil Refinery Plant in Orissa;
- (b) whether the Government has decided to start the construction work of the plant without any further delay;
- (c) the estimated cost of the plant; and
- (d) the time by which the production from this plant is likely to be started?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS AND MINISTER OF PANCHAYATI RAJ (SHRI MANI SHANKAR AIYAR):

(a) to (d) A Memorandum of UnderÂstanding (MoU) has been signed between Government of Orissa and Indian Oil Corporation Limited (IOCL) on 16-2.2004 according to which IOCL will initiate all necessary steps to complete the construction of the refinery by the year 2009-10. However, if market conditions in the country favour higher levels of domestic sale of products from the refinery as compared to earlier estimates, IOCL will endeavour to complete the project by 2008-09 The estimated cost of the project based on October, 2002 prices is Rs. 7,500 crore.
