(a) Funds have been released for creation of durable assets for the use of public at large which are recommended by the concerned Members of Parliament and sanctioned by the District Authorities. The list of projects include buildings for schools and libraries, provision of drinking water facilities, roads, bridges, sports stadia, community centres, crematoria, public toilets, drains, footpaths, b us stop, health centres, public irrigation and electrification projects and to purchase computers for Government educational institutions for the benefit of students at large. The details in this regard are available with the District Administrations.

(b) and (c) During the Financial Year 2003-04, Rs. 1580 crore budgeted amount and additional fund of Rs. 102 crore were released to the Districts.

(d) The State-wise details of the fund released during 2003-04 are given in the Annexure.
