(a),(b)&(c): As per the information received from the Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion, they do not have any proposal for the import of soft wood. The wood, including soft wood, are classified under Chapter 44 of Import Trade Classification (Harmonized Systems) and are freely importable under Open General Licence. Further, under the liberalized economic regime, investment decisions, including those relating to imports, are taken by entrepreneurs based on their commercial perceptions.
