(a) to (e) Yes, Sir. UNICEF organized a National Consultation on children affected by HIV/AIDS in 2005. As a follow-up, a study is being undertaken to examine the barriers to services for children with HIV positive parents or orphaned by AIDS.

The above study is in its final stages and no report has been submitted so far.
