(a): Urban Transport is a State subject. It is the responsibility of the State Governments to plan and introduce appropriate Mass Rapid Transit Systems. On the basis of proposals submitted by the Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) Ltd., along with detailed project reports at the requests of the Governments of Haryana & Uttar Pradesh, Government has approved extension of Delhi Metro to Gurgaon and NOIDA subject to certain conditions.
