- (a): The Ministry of Small Scale Industries administers Integrated Infrastructural Development (IID) Scheme. State-wise information regarding IID Centres approved in the last three years and current year is at Annexure- A. No IID Centre has been opened in Karnataka during the said period.
- (b): The details of funds released to IID Centres during the same period are at Annexure-B.
- (c): The IID Scheme is demand driven and the initiative for setting up IID Centres has to be taken by State Governments.
