(a)&(b): The Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission

(JNNURM) has been launched in Dec., 2005 to address the issue of infrastructure development including water and sanitation and basic services to the urban poor. The Sub-Mission Basic Services to the Urban Poor (BSUP) covers 63 identified cities. The Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme (IHSDP) covers housing and slum upgradation in non-Mission cities. The fund sharing pattern between Centre and States is as per Annexure `A`.
