- (a) & (b) The Government of India is implementing a number of Plan Schemes for the development of handloom sector and welfare of handloom weavers. These include:
- (i) Deen Dayal Hathkargha Protsahan Yojana (DDHPY).
- (ii) Workshed-cum-Housing Scheme.
- (iii) Weavers Welfare Scheme:
- Thrift Fund Scheme
- New Insurance SchemeHealth Package Scheme
- (iv) Handloom Export Scheme.
- (v) Marketing Promotion Programme Scheme.
- (vi) Design Development & Training Programme
- (vii) Mill Gate Price Scheme.
- (viii) Integrated Handloom Training Project (IHTP).
- (ix) Bunkar Bima Yojana.

A provision of Rs.154.56 crore has been made in BE 2004-05 for the above schemes. Under the above Schemes a sum of Rs,79.84 crore has been released during the current financial year upto 31/10/2004.
