(b \& c) Yes, Sir. Warnings issued to Chief Secretary of Gujarat Government during the recent heavy rainfall situations are detailed below:

## Date Warnings 2/7/06

The enhanced rainfall activity will continue and expected to increase with extremely heavy rainfall ( $=25 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) likely at one or two places over south Gujarat during next 3-4 days.3/7/06

The rainfall activity will continue with extremely heavy rainfall $(=25 \mathrm{~cm})$ likely at one or two places over south Gujarat during next 2-3 days 4/7/06

Scattered heavy to very heavy rainfall over Gujarat State during subsequent 2-3 days.5/7/06
Widespread rains with scattered heavy to very heavy falls and isolated extremely heavy falls ( $=25 \mathrm{cms}$ ) over Gujarat State during next 48 hours.5/8/06

Widespread rainfall with heavy to very heavy falls at a few places are also likely over Gujarat region during next 2-3 days.18/8/06
Widespread rainfall with heavy to very heavy falls at a few places are likely over north Gujarat region during next 24 hours.
