- (a) whether the Government is aware that posts for lecturers of Regional Languages particularly Oriya and Telugu under the department of Modern Indian Languages and Literary Studies of Delhi University are lying vacant:

(a) to (e) According to the information furnished by the University of Delhi, no post of lecturer in Oriya is vacant in the Department of Modern Indian Languages and Literary Studies of the University and the certificate, diploma, advance diploma, M.Phil and Ph.D. courses in Oriya are being offered by the Department. However, these courses in Telugu are present not being run because of two vacancies of lecturer in Telugu in the Department. The University has already set in motion the process for filling up these vacancies.
