- (b)& (c) The Government is aware of the report. The report is not India specific. However, steps are taken to ensure transparency and minimize corruption in the centrally assisted programmes in the education sector, which include, provisions regarding community ownership and monitoring of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA), independent monitoring by academic and professional institutes, as well as statutory audit of all accounts by chartered accountants and external audit by C&AG.
