- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

- (c) to (e) Any allegation of corruption and irregularity is got looked into by the Ministry. The complaints are investigated through the Chief Vigilance Officers of the companies. Advice of Central Vigilance Commission is also obtained in case any of the officers involved come in their jurisdiction.
