SCHEMES FOR WELFARE OF WOMEN AND GIRLS

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of proposals sent by the Madhya Pradesh under the Centrally Sponsored Schemes for the protection, welfare and rehabilitation of women/girls during the three years and thereafter;
- (b) the action being taken by the Government on the said proposals;
- (c) the number of proposals cleared so far; and
- (d) the time by which the remaining proposals are likely to be cleared?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI KANTI SINGH):

- (a) During the last three years, three proposals have been sent by Madhya Pradesh under Swadhar scheme and 103 proposals under Short Stay Home (SSH).
- (b) The proposals under the scheme of Swadhar and Short Stay Home are placed before the Project Sanctioning Committee of the Department of Women & Child Development.
- (c) 2 proposals of Swadhar and 19 under Short Stay Home were cleared by the Project Sanctioning Committee (PSC) of the Department of Women & Child Development.
- (d) 1 proposal under Swadhar and 84 under Short Stay Home (SSH) have been referred back to State Government for attending to deficiencies. Hence no proposal is pending with Department of Women & Child Development.
