Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Group C and D staff particularly nurse of various Government hospitals of Delhi do not display name plates on their uniform as a result of which patients have to face difficulties in registering complaints against the employees who misbehave with them:
- (a) if so, whether the Government proposes to make it compulsory for the Group D and C staff to show name plates on their uniforms in every Government hospitals in Delhi; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

(a) to (c): In Central Government Hospitals in Delhi i.e. Safdarjung Hospital, Dr. R.M.L. Hospital and Lady Hardinge Medical College & Associated Hospitals, some of the Group C & D Staff including the Nurses use their nameplates on the uniforms. However, instructions have been issued by the respective Hospital authorities to Group `C` and Group `D` staff to wear their uniform with nameplates while on duty.
