- (a) whether the EMR has been granted for a number of drug items;
- (b) if so, the names of drugs and other details; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government in regard to the licences of the drugs already available in the market?

- (a) & (b): The Exclusive Marketing Rights (EMR) has been granted for following drugs formulations by the Central Government Patent office, Kolkata -
- 1. Glivec a brand of anti-cancer drug Imatinib Mesylate. M/s. Novartis AG, Switzerland has been granted EMR on beta crystalline form of Imatinib Mesylate on 10th November, 2003.
- 2. Nadifloxacin 1% Cream : EMR has been granted on 15.12.2003.
- 3. Tadalafil Tablets 10/20 mg EMR has been granted to M/s. Eli Lilly & Company, USA on 26.8.2004.
- (c) As per information furnished by the O/o Controller General Patents, Designs and Trademarks any Indian Company can manufacture the product Nadifloxacin 1% cream based on the invention disclosed in US patent No. 4399134 dated 10/11/1981 because this invention is not protected as an Indian patent under the Patents Act 1970. Regarding Glivec & Tadalafil formulations, matter is sub-judice as Indian Manufacturers of these durgs have filed Writs in High Courts.
