(e) whether the Union Government has received some proposals/requests from various State Governments regarding development and improvement of national highways during the last three years till date; and

(f) if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Government on the said proposals/requests?

(a) The total length of the National Highways in the country at present is 65,569 km. State-wise details are at Annexure-I. National Highways are not declared based on the demographic features of the State. The details of National Highways in tribal areas are not separately maintained.

(b) The year-wise funds allocated to State Governments for maintenance of National Highways during last three years are as under:

(c) The State-wise and year-wise details of funds remained unutilised with States are at Annexure-II.

(d) Non-utilisation of funds allocated for maintenance and repair have been mainly due to the problem of issue of Letter of Credit in time by State Governments, law & order problems in some states and late receipt of estimates for maintenance work from some State Governments.

(e) & (f) During the last 3 years and till 30th November, 2004 for development of National Highways 2450 numbers of works amounting to Rs. 5,793.07 crore have been sanctioned.
