- (a) & (b): The Government has received a representation from the All India Federation of State Civil/Administrative Service Associations placing before the Government some issues relating to the service conditions of State Civil Service (SCS) officers. The issues are broadly for providing greater opportunities for SCS officers for career advancement viz., increase of promotional avenues for SCS officers into IAS, constitution of a National Pay Commission for SCS officers, regular and timely holding of Selection Committees for promotions, directing State Governments for creating parallel and additional opportunities for SCS officers for their career advancement etc.
- (c) & (d): The issues raised by the Association were examined by the Government. No changes in the existing rules and regulations are proposed.
