(a) to (d): The All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), which is mandated for proper planning and co-ordinated development of technical education throughout the country, invite applications for establishment of technical institutions from Trust/Societies/State Governments/Universities which are processed as per the Approval Process and are approved if found to be fulfilling the required norms and standards. The AICTE has not received any proposal from the Gujarat State till date for establishment of a World Class Engineering College at Vadodara.
