- (a) the criteria fixed for providing assistance to voluntary organization/agencies engaged in welfare of women and children/dissemination and spread of women education;
- (b) the amount released by the Government to each of these organizations during the last three years and till date, state-wise;
- (c) the details of agencies which are monitoring and auditing such organizations;
- (d) whether the working of these organizations has been reviewed; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

- (a)The basic criteria used for selection of NGOs and other agencies for operating the programmes of Department of Women and Child Development include the following:
- (i) Registered under one of the relevant statutory acts.
- (ii) In existence for a period of at least three years after registration.
- (iii) Have audited statements of Accounts for last three years.
- (iv) Financially sound.
- (v) Recommendation of State Governments/State Level Empowered Committees constituted for the purpose.
- (vi) Experience in relevant field.
- (b)Details of the agencies to whom funds were released state-wise and scheme-wise for the last three years are available in the respective Annual Reports of the Department. The information for the current year is annexed.
- (c), (d) & (e) A system exists to review the performance of various organizations through periodical reports from State Governments by monitoring agencies, review meetings and field visits by the concerned Area Officers.
