- (a) whether the Government gives subsidy on Highway Projects in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise particularly in Bihar and Maharashtra;
- (c) the details of build-operate-transfer projects under the National Highways Development Projects as on date; and
- (d) the names of entrepreneurs who have been empanelled for Non-NHDP projects to be taken up on a BOT basis?

- (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. The Government has a policy to provide subsidy upto 40% of capital cost on highway projects, which are taken up with private sector participation on Build Operate and Transfer (BOT), on case to case basis, to enhance project viability. Details of such projects are placed at Annexure -I.
- (c) The details of BOT projects undertaken under the National Highways Development Project are placed at Annexure-II.
- (d)The names of entrepreneurs empanelled with NHAI for projects under Non-NHDP i.e. Pradhan Mantri Bharat Jodo Pariyojana, are placed at Annexure-III.
