- (d) whether the Government makes any physical verification of actual supply of these items in the PDS shops;
- (e) if so, the details thereof and the frequency thereof;
- (f) whether the Government proposes to bring more commodities under PDS/TPDS; and
- (g) if so, the details thereof?

- (b): The Public Distribution System is in operation all over the country.
- (c): The Central Government presently makes available to the States wheat, rice, kerosene and sugar for distribution to the consumers under the Targetted Public Distribution System. Some States also distribute additional items of mass consumption through the Fair Price Shops such as cloth, exercise books, pulses, salt, tea etc.
- (d)&(e):The management of Fair Price Shops for distribution of commodities under PDS including verification of supply of items rests with the State Governments and UT Administrations.
- (f)&(g):There is at present no proposal to bring more commodities under PDS/TPDS.
