(a) & (b) A list of States where Tiger Reserves are located, along with allocation of funds made to each of them during the last three years and current year, is annexed (Annexure I).

(c) & (d) The objective of `Project Tiger` is to ensure and maintain viable populations of tigers in India and to preserve for all times areas of biological importance as national heritage for the benefit of education and enjoyment of people. Viable populations of tigers have been successfully maintained in tiger reserves set up under the project, as at Annexure II. The project has successfully preserved the national biological heritage in the form of Tiger Reserves and thus has been acclaimed as a role model for wildlife conservation.
