- (a) & (b): Under Border Area Development Programme (BADP) Govt. of Assam has submitted their Annual Action Plan for the year 2007-08 proposing special works in the identified border blocks relating to development of Model Villages, link roads, bridges/culverts, community centers, drinking water facilities, electrification in villages, solar street lights.
- (c): The Annual Action Plan has been approved and first installment of Rs. 1344.67 lakh out of the total allocation of Rs. 2017.00 lakh has been released to the State Government.
