- (a) whether the Government proposes to allocate funds to States to set up English Language Teaching Institutes;
- (b) if so, the details of funds allocated to each State;
- (c) the number of States utilized the funds allocated for the purpose; and
- (d) the action taken by the Government against those States who have not utilized funds fully?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SMT. D. PURANDESWARI)

- (a): Financial assistance from the Central Government is given for running the English Language Teaching Institutes (ELTI) support scheme and for organizing programmes at the ELTIs and Regional Institutes of English. No financial assistance is given by the Central Government to set up ELTIs. State Governments set up the institutes with the approval of the Central Government. Subsequently, each institute is financially supported by the State Government and the Central Government on fifty-fifty basis.
- (b) to (d): Although the ELTIs are set up by the State Governments, the funds are provided by the Central Government for running the scheme on a sharing basis. The amount released during the last 3 years to the States under ELTI Scheme is as follows:-
