- (a) &(b): Yes, Sir. The Annual Action Plan submitted by the Maharashtra State AIDS Control Society has been approved and an outlay of Rs. 6672.89 lakhs has been sanctioned for 2007-08.
- (c) & (d): Phase III of the National AIDS Control Programme has been formulated to control the spread of HIV by up scaling targeted interventions among the high risk groups, behaviour change communication for improved awareness, expanding preventive care, blood safety, support and treatment of HIV infected persons including the treatment of opportunistic infections, provision of anti-retroviral drugs and mainstreaming of HIV intervention strategies.
