(a) to (d): Electrification of Lucknow-Barabanki section has already been completed. Barabanki-Gorakhpur rail line is a part of Barabanki-Gonda-Barauni railway electrification project which has been included at a cost of Rs.526.44 crore in Rail Budget 2007-08 with an outlay of Rs.0.50 crore for preliminary works. The entire section is targeted for completion by March 2012.
