(a) & (b): Under the provisions of Disaster Management Act, 2005, a National Disaster Management Authority has been set up. The primary responsibility for undertaking relief and rehabilitation measures in areas affected by natural calamities is of the concerned State Governments. Government of India supplements the efforts of the State Governments in providing support for these measures. Under the Schemes of Calamity Relief Fund (CRF) and National Calamity Contingency Fund (NCCF), the Government of India provides assistance to the State Governments, which also covers gratuitous relief to the affected persons not having food reserves or whose food reserves have been lost due to calamity and those who do not have immediate means of support.
