Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) the criteria adopted for declaring a sport as National Game;
- (b) whether Judo and Karate are National Games;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the steps taken to promote the said sports?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS (SHRI SUNIL DUTT)

- (a): There is no Scheme of Government of India for declaring a sport as National Game.
- (b) to (c): Do not arise.
- (d): To encourage a particular sports discipline, the concerned National Sports Federation is primarily responsible. However, Government also supplements their efforts in this regard. In so far as 'Judo' is concerned, it falls under 'General Category' and Government provides assistance for coaching camps under Indian and foreign coaches with required scientific input and equipment support; provides financial assistance for holding National/International Championships and competition/training abroad; and gives incentive to meritorious sports persons. As regards 'Karate', it falls unnder 'Others' category and Government provides financial assistance for holding National Championships.
