- (a) & (b) The Netherlands Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Economic Affairs, Mr. Laurens Jan Brinkhorst paid an official visit to India in October 2005. In a meeting with the Commerce and Industry Minister, the two sides discussed inter-alia, on the economic scenario in the two countries; enlarging the basket of trade; enhancing cooperation in areas like Science and Technology, Information Technology; India's strength in Food Processing Industries; visa problems faced by Indian businessmen; WTO negotiation on Agriculture.
- (c), (d) & (e) No Agreement was signed by the Department of Commerce during the visit. However, a Memorandum of Understanding was signed between Department of Biotechnology and Netherlands` Institute of Higher Education for Cooperation in Biotechnology with an aim to find solutions to problems in agricultural and health areas.
