(a)to(c): The Delhi Development Authority (DDA) has reported that it has, in its meeting held on 9.8.2007, decided that barring those cases where directions have been received from the Courts, plots should not be allotted in future for rehabilitation of eligible slum dwellers. Instead, they should be provided `low cost housing` flats. In view of this, DDA is to undertake construction of `low cost housing` projects/flats.
