(a) & (b): The 11th Five Year Plan has not yet been finalized, as such details are not feasible to be given at this stage. However, as mentioned in Budget Speech 2007-08, efforts would be made to convert the majority of the Metre Gauge lines to Broad Gauge during the 11th Five Year Plan. There are 55 ongoing gauge conversion projects which require about Rs.11,500 crore (as on 1.4.2007) for completion. These projects on completion would add about 7500 kms of broad gauge lines.
