## MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI PRANAB MUKHERJEE)

- (a) & (b): The Government has decided that the investigation relating to the tapes be entrusted to the CBI so as to determine the extent of offences, procedural violations, misconduct, impropriety and guilt of the individuals involved. The CBI has not yet started the investigation.
- (c) Does not arise.
- (d) No time-frame has been laid down by the Government for completion of investigation by the CBI.
