- (a) whether there is any proposal for laying new railway track between Nadikudi and Srikalahasti which falls under the backward area of Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the time by when a final decision in this regard is likely to be taken?

- (a) & (b): The survey for Nadikudi-Srikalahasti new line was completed in 2004-05. As per the survey report, cost of construction of this 309 kms. long new line was assessed as Rs.711.52 crore. The survey report is under examination in consultation with South Central Railway.
- (c): No time frame is feasible to be given in this regard.
